Part-time studies

The Master Facility & Real Estate Management is also offered in part-time. Part-time students have classes one day a week and the expected weekly work load is about 20 hours. When choosing the part-time offering you'll get started with Critical thinking, Strategic Facility Management, Strategic Building Management, Strategic Asset Management and Multiple Value Creation. In the second year you'll complete the subjects Research Methodology, Leadership & Change and your thesis research and defense.

Admission requirements and procedure

The Master is a selected entry programme in which we accept a maximum of 25 students per year. We receive more applications than we can place. The sooner you apply, the better your chances of securing yourself in the programme. If you meet the following entry requirements we will invite you for an intake interview with Programme Director Joop van Duren. During this conversation, in English, you can present yourself and elaborate on your motivation for the master.

Entry requirements

- ◆ Valid academic bachelor degree in Facility Management/ Real Estate Management/ Architecture/ Built Environment/ Urban Planning/ Hotel Management/ Economics/ Business Administration/ International Business or other relevant field - enabling you to follow a master degree in the Netherlands.
- ◆ – IELTS level 6.0 in English
 - Motivation letter
 - Curriculum Vitae
